There will be a date on your smoke alarm.



The Regulatory Compliance Mark

After a recent recall of a Kmart table lamp that posed the risk of electric shock from the lamp the Lighting Council Australia is calling on the compliance for lighting products and other consumer electronics.

When purchasing products ensure the product is marked with the Australian Electrical Equipment Safety System (EESS) Regulatory Compliance Mark (picture below).



THINKING OF INSTALLING FANS FOR SUMMER

With Spring already heating up have you been discussing installing fans or replacing your old fan.

Over the years we found that customers want to install fans at the time we are experiencing really hot weather and want to install their fan/s within a week as they are suffering. Be aware that fans do sell out and shipments leading up to Christmas get delayed.

Miles will tell you "gone are the days where there were 2 types of fans rattan up or rattan down" and we prefer for you to choose your own fan as there are now so many to styles and colours to choose from.

Things to think about when purchasing a fan:-

AC Fans

- Reasonable start up expenses
- Energy Efficient

- Summer/Winter Modes

DC Fans

- Doesn't make the whirring sound and quieter than that of AC fans make
- Move the air around in gentle breezes
- Energy Efficient
- Summer/Winter Modes

Number of Blades

- The more blades the more energy it uses as they usually require a larger motor to move the blades.
- Consider the size of the room
- The more blades the quieter the fan will be

REMINDER TO SET YOUR EXISTING FANS TO SUMMER MODE SETTING

Summer modes spin counter-clockwise to direct cool air to the ground.

The Summer/Winter mode can be found as a switch on the side of the fan or on the remote control.

As the size of the fan you require depends on the size of the room, we advise measuring it. The length of the blades must be greater to allow sufficient air movement in a larger room.

225 - 400 ft ² (20m ² to 36m ²)	56" - 80"	142cm - 203cm
